the said Person, Stock or Goods provided
he behave himself loyally and peaceably
under Their Majesties Government, and
make restitution of all ^{incommodities} ~~incommodities~~ ^{and} ~~and~~ ^{and}
~~or any~~ ^{or any} ~~things~~ ^{things} as he has taken from, or
received of any Protestant, and as shall be
legally made appear to remain now in his
possession; but protect and defend them from
Violence and Injury, as you will answer the
contrary at your peril. Given at the
Camp at Aghrim this 15 day of
July 1691.
